(STONEYGATE LANE, RIBCHESTER, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stoneygate Lane, Ribchester from its junction with Clitheroe Road travelling in a northerly direction for approximately 50 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until 1600 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Clitheroe Road – Lower Road – Lower Lane – Dilworth Lane – Higher Road – Forty Acre Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Broadband Rural North to install fibre broadband connections works.
