(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Queen Street, Lancaster from outside property No.6 to outside property No.12.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 30th July 2024 until 1800 hours on Thursday 1st August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible by use of road ramps. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out.
