NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Main Street, Overton from outside the Globe Hotel to its junction with First Terrace.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 22nd July 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 30th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties and businesses will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- N/A no through route.

Works are weather dependent and may not be carried out on the dates specified.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.
