LYTHAM ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Lytham Road, Preston from its junction with Haddon Place to outside of number 86 Lytham Road.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1200 hours on Monday 1st July 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 3rd July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repairs to a leaking water main to be carried out.
