NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to have made Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Combermere Road, Heysham from A683 Trumacar Lane to its junction with Heathfoot Drive.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0600 hours and 1800 hours from Tuesday 16th July 2024 until Wednesday 31st July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:
 Delamere Avenue Heathfoot Avenue Smithy Lane Middleton
 Road A589 Middleton Road A683 Middleton Road A683 Trumacar
 Lane.

Works are weather dependent and may not be carried out on the dates specified.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway Surface Dressing Works to be carried out.
