(B5272 GARSTANG ROAD, COCKERHAM, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of B5272 Garstang Road, Cockerham from its junction with Crookhey Gardens for a distance of approximately 520 metres in a south easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2100 hours on Monday 29th July 2024 until 0600 hours on Tuesday 30th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency Services access will be maintained when safe passage permits.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
B5272 Garstang Road – Cockerham Road – A6 Lancaster Road – Ratcliffe Wharf Lane - B5272 Park Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow access to underground structure on behalf of Openreach.
