DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

This Order is made by Lancashire County Council (the "Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) and 53(3)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) namely the discovery by the Surveying Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description, namely footpath, ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description, namely a restricted byway.

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Lancashire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order, the relevant date is 18th May 2022.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Lancashire County Council Restricted Byway along Moss Lane, Overton Definitive Map Modification Order 2022.

PART I

MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE UPGRADED

Restricted byway known as Moss Lane from Downeyfield Road immediately to the east of Downeyfield Bridge (at point A on the Order Map) in a generally south south easterly direction to Middleton Road immediately east of Middlepool Bridge (point B). The entire route is shown between points A and B on the Order Map with a dashed green line.

The length of the route is 0.88km and the width varies between 5 metres and 12 metres.

VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH OR WAY

No. of Path: "1"

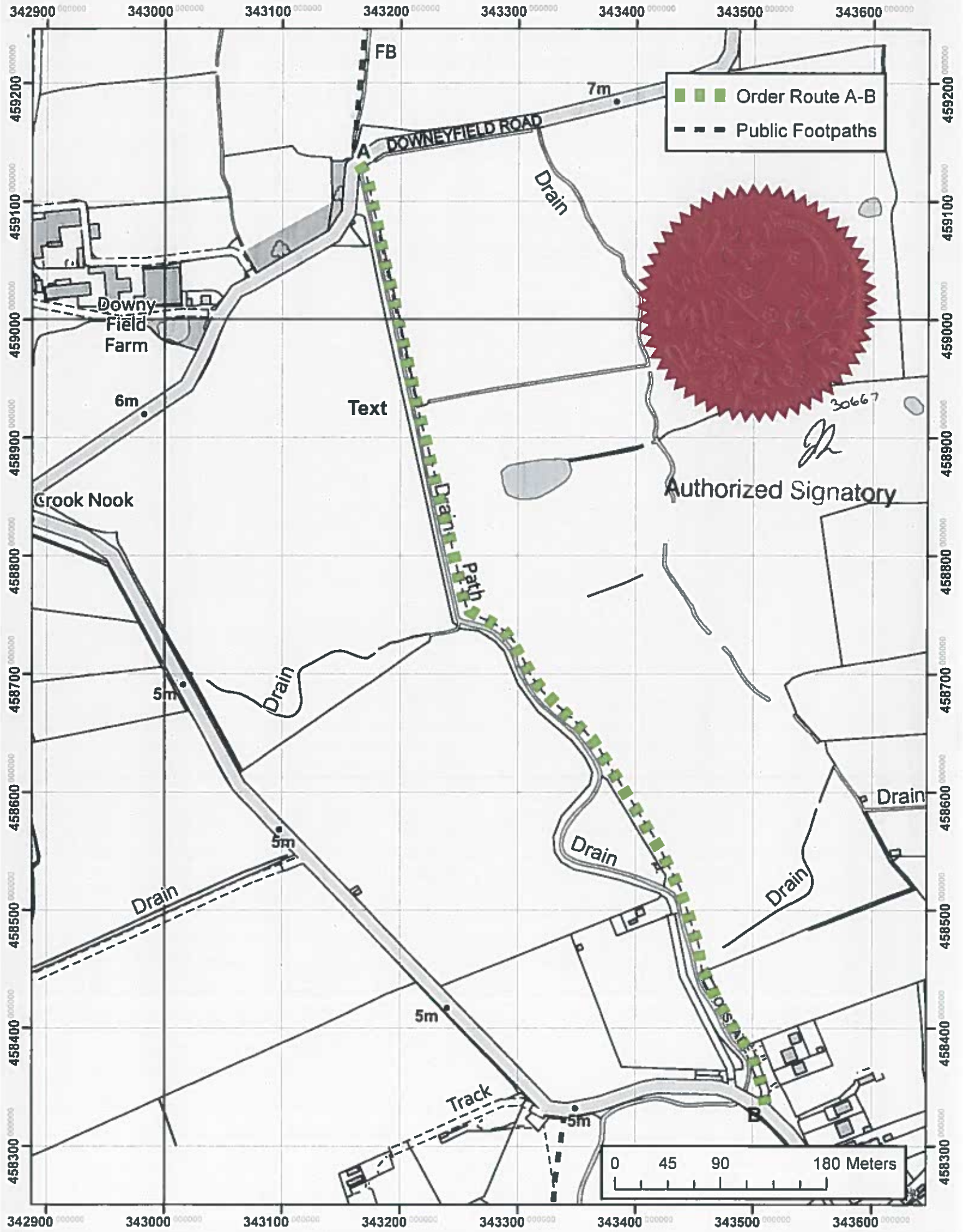
Kind of Path: "Restricted Byway"

Position: "Restricted byway known as Moss Lane from Downeyfield Road immediately to the east of Downeyfield Bridge at SD 4316 5912 in a generally south south easterly direction to Middleton Road immediately east of Middlepool Bridge at SD 4351 5833."

Width: Varying between 5 and 12 metres as shown on the Ordnance Survey 25 inch Sheet XXXIV.1, surveyed 1890 and published 1891.

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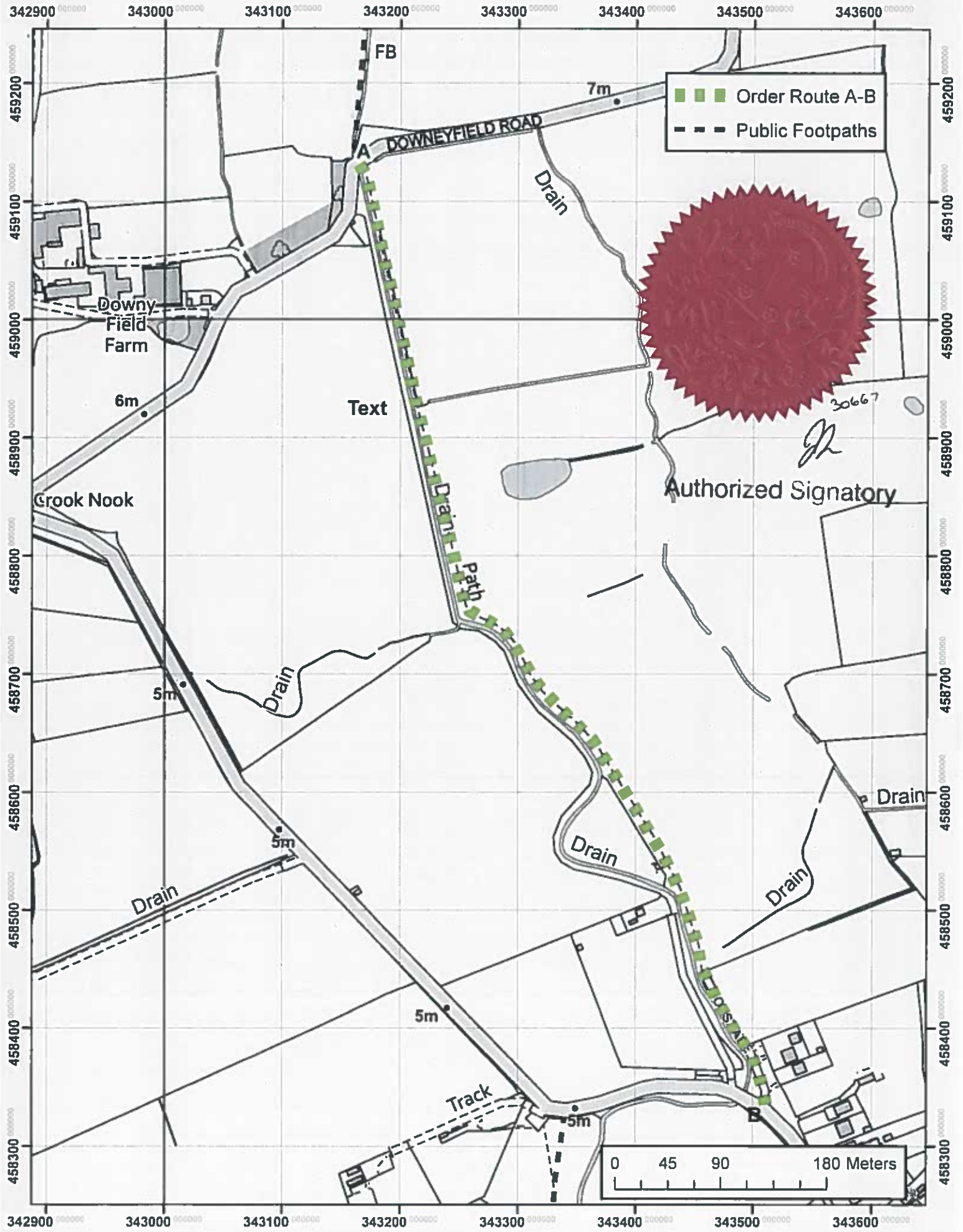
