(CHAPEL PARK ROAD AND BROWNHILL LANE, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the South Ribble Borough:
 - a. Chapel Park Road, Longton from Chapel Lane, Longton to Brownhill Lane, Longton.
 - b. Brownhill Lane, Longton from Chapel Park Road, Longton to Thropps Lane, Longton
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 29th July 2024 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 6th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. Alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Clockwise Diversion

Brownhill Lane, Longton – Drumacre Lane East, Longton – Land Lane, Longton – Gill Lane, Longton – Longton Bypass, Little Hoole – Liverpool Road, Little Hoole – Liverpool Road, Longton – Chapel Lane, Longton.

Anticlockwise Diversion

Chapel Lane, New Longton – Longton Bypass, Longton – Drumacre Lane East, Longton.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out.
