ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LANGTHWAITE BROW AND WYRESDALE ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (REVOCATION AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under 83(2) and Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Revocation

That part of the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Lancaster, Pendle and Ribble Valley Boroughs) (Revocation, 20mph, 30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 2019", as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order, is hereby revoked.

2. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on any of the lengths of road as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

3. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

4. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the ** day of ** 202* and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Langthwaite Brow And Wyresdale Road, Lancaster, Lancaster City) (Revocation And 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*".
