(C124 MICKERING LANE, AUGHTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C124 Mickering Lane, Aughton from B5197 Prescot Road, South of Aughton to a point 15m West of the Western Boundary of the property named The Orchard.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours from Sunday 21st July 2024 until Saturday 27th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- Vehicular access for residents and businesses, including HGVs, will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5197 Prescot Road, South of Aughton – C117 Town Green Lane, Aughton – C117 Bold Lane, Aughton – C124 Sandy Lane, Aughton – C124 Mickering Lane, Aughton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
