(LAMBS ROAD, THORNTON CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lambs Road, Thornton Cleveleys for approximately 300 metres in a northerly direction to the Stanah Road roundabout.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5th August 2024 until 1630 hours on Sunday 11th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Station Road – Victoria Road East – Fleetwood Road South –
Amounderness Way – Breck Road – Skippool Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Section 50 works to construct a new manhole to be carried out by MJ Evans Construction.
