TO GIVE A GRID REFERENCE CORRECT TO 100 METRES

Take west edge of kilometre square in which point lies and read the large figures printed opposite this line on north or south margins. Full 100 Metre Reference SD 871412

The above Full Reference is unique. For many purposes the first grid letter can be omitted, giving a reference, D 871412 which recurs at intervals of 500 Kilometres. If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference 871412 recurs at intervals of 100 Kilometres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case with maps on scales of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.

At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 0°07' East of Grid North and at the Western edge 0°11' East of Grid North. Magnetic North was about 94° West of Grid North in 1955 decreasing by about 1" in four years. Heights are in feet above Mean Sea Level at Newlyn.
