
**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1. Introduce a junction table in the following locations:
  - a) Chingle Hall Crescent, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Goosnargh Lane for a distance of 9.7 metres in a northerly direction.
  - b) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Goosnargh Lane and Chingle Hall Crescent for a distance of 9.2 metres in a westerly direction.
  - c) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Goosnargh Lane and Chingle Hall Crescent for a distance of 9.2 metres in an easterly direction.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 65mm.

- 2. Introduce speed humps in the following locations:
  - a) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, Preston from a point 50 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Chingle Hall Crescent for a distance of 8.6 metres in an easterly direction;
  - b) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, Preston from a point 61 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Chingle Hall Crescent for a distance of 8.6 metres in a westerly direction.

The speed humps will have a maximum height not exceeding 65mm.



## **Statement of Reasons**

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development which will introduce further traffic movements at the junction of Goosnargh Lane.

The purpose of the proposed junction table and two road humps is to slow traffic and allow safe passage of pedestrians due to the increase in traffic from the new housing development.
