REAR 1 TO 23 LENNOX STREET, WORTHORNE-WITH-HURSTWOOD, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 1 to 23 Lennox Street, Worsthorne-with-Hurstwood from its junction with Gordon Street to approximately the rear of 13 Lennox Street.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1335 hours on Friday 12th July 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 15th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that Rear 1 to 23 Lennox Street, Worsthone-with-Hurstwood is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent repair to leaking water valve to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
