MARSH LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Marsh Lane, Preston from 20 metres either side of the railway bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2230 hours on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2024 until 0600 hours on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. The bus gate on Corporation Street, Preston shall be temporarily suspended for the operational hours of this closure to act as part of the diversion route.
- 6. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Marsh Lane – Ring Way – Corporation Street – Leighton Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow structure examination works to be carried out.
