

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

### **CHORLEY**

#### **Brown Street and Wright Street, Chorley**

Concerns were raised by the local school and school road safety officer regarding parked vehicles causing an obstruction around the junction of Brown Street and Wright Street.

Site visits were carried out on different days and at different times of the day, confirming the concerns that had been raised, as a number of vehicles were parked at this location.

The purpose of this proposal is to introduce No Waiting At Any Time restrictions to remove the potential for vehicles to park in an obstructive manner near to this junction. This will seek to improve access, sightlines and help to maintain the flow of traffic thereby increasing safety for highway users.

#### **Dole Lane and Bolton Road, Abbey Village**

The purpose of this proposal is to facilitate the passage of vehicles along the road and improve overall road safety by preventing parking which has a potential to result in vehicles travelling a significant distance whilst conflicting with opposing traffic flows. The proposal will reduce these extents and provide parking free sections allowing vehicles room to perform overtaking manoeuvres in a staged manner.

The proposal also seeks to amend the Traffic Regulation Order on Bolton Road to ensure that the legal Order matches the markings that are currently on site allowing for effective enforcement.
