(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Washington Lane, Euxton from its junction with Whinney Lane to its junction with West Way.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1700 hours on Wednesday 24th July 2024 until Friday 26th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

West Way – Southport Road – Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out by Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of BT Openreach.
