

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HASLINGDEN ROAD, RAWTENSTALL, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in an easterly direction over that length of Haslingden Road, Rawtenstall from the Manchester Road roundabout junction for a distance of approximately 200 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 23rd July 2024 until 1600 hours on 3rd September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to side roads will be maintained along the length on the closure. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Dismounted cyclist will be permitted along the footway through the closure.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
A56 – Rawtenstall Spur – Haslingden Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains diversion works to be carried out.
