(DUTTON STREET – ST JAMES STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Dutton Street, Accrington, from outside number 9 Dutton Street to its junction with Blackburn Road.
2. No person shall cause any pedestrian to proceed over that length of footway on the east side of St. James Street, Accrington, from outside number 3 St. James Street to its junction with Blackburn Road.
3. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
4. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 16th July 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 4th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to facilitate building repair works to Burtons Chambers.
