(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bury Lane from its junction with Livesey Fold for 50 metres in a north westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0830 hours to 1500 on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Dole Lane – Bolton Road – Blackburn Road – Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out by Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of BT Openreach.
