(U636 HELMSDALE, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U636 Helmsdale, Skelmersdale from the northern boundary of the property number 53 in a southerly direction to the end of the road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 13th August 2024 until 1600 hours on Monday 19th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U636 Helmsdale, Skelmersdale is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new service connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
