(U489 NIPE LANE, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U489 Nipe Lane, Skelmersdale from the western boundary of the property named Moss Farm to a point 50m Northwest of its junction with U3006 Holland Moss, Skelmersdale.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Tuesday 13th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bushey Lane, St Helens Council – A570 Rainford Bypass, St Helens Council (into Lancashire) – A570 Rainford Road, Junction Three Of Motorway (Bickerstaffe) – B5312 Skelmersdale Road, Bickerstaffe – B5312 Liverpool Road, Skelmersdale – B5312 Railway Road, Skelmersdale – B5312 Grimshaw Road, Skelmersdale – C154 Whiteledge Road, Skelmersdale and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
