NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C135 Bescar Lane, Scarisbrick from the southern boundary of property number 176 to a point 110m North East of the property named Bescar House Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 13th August 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 22nd August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5242 Hall Rad, Scarisbrick – B5242 Dam Wood Lane, Scarisbrick – C134 Drummersdale Lane, Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
