NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in a Westbound direction over that length of A577 Neverstitch Road, Skelmersdale from U517 School Lane, Skelmersdale to X151 Old Engine Lane, Lathom.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2100 hours on Tuesday 13th August 2024 until 0600 hours on Wednesday 14th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A577 Neverstitch Road, Skelmersdale – A5068 Glenburn Road, Skelmersdale – B5312 Railway Road, Skelmersdale – A577 Neverstitch Road, Skelmersdale.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow desilting works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals UK on behalf of BT.
