(U557 TAYLOR STREET, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U557 Taylor Street, Skelmersdale in its entirety.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U557 Taylor Street, Skelmersdale is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow remedial works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
