SANDYLANDS AND WEST END SAFER, GREENER AND HEALTHIER STREETS PLANS.

In January this year we sent letters outlining proposals for a Safer, Greener and Healthier Streets project in the Sandylands and West End area of Morecambe. We invited you to come along to drop-in sessions at Morecambe Library to find out more about the scheme and how you could have your say on what you felt the issues were in your area. The scheme is aiming to help local people to use more sustainable forms of transport and enjoy their neighbourhood thanks to lower traffic levels and slower speeds. It will also make it easier for people to choose to walk, cycle or wheel for local trips rather than using the car.

Following on from the previous engagement and online survey (results can be found at <u>https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/active-travel/sandylands/</u>), we hosted another drop-in session to show what the most common issues were and ask what interventions people would like to see. We are using an online survey to collect this information, where people can see the location of the main issues and choose the type of interventions they'd like to see. The survey is open until the 29th July 2024.
