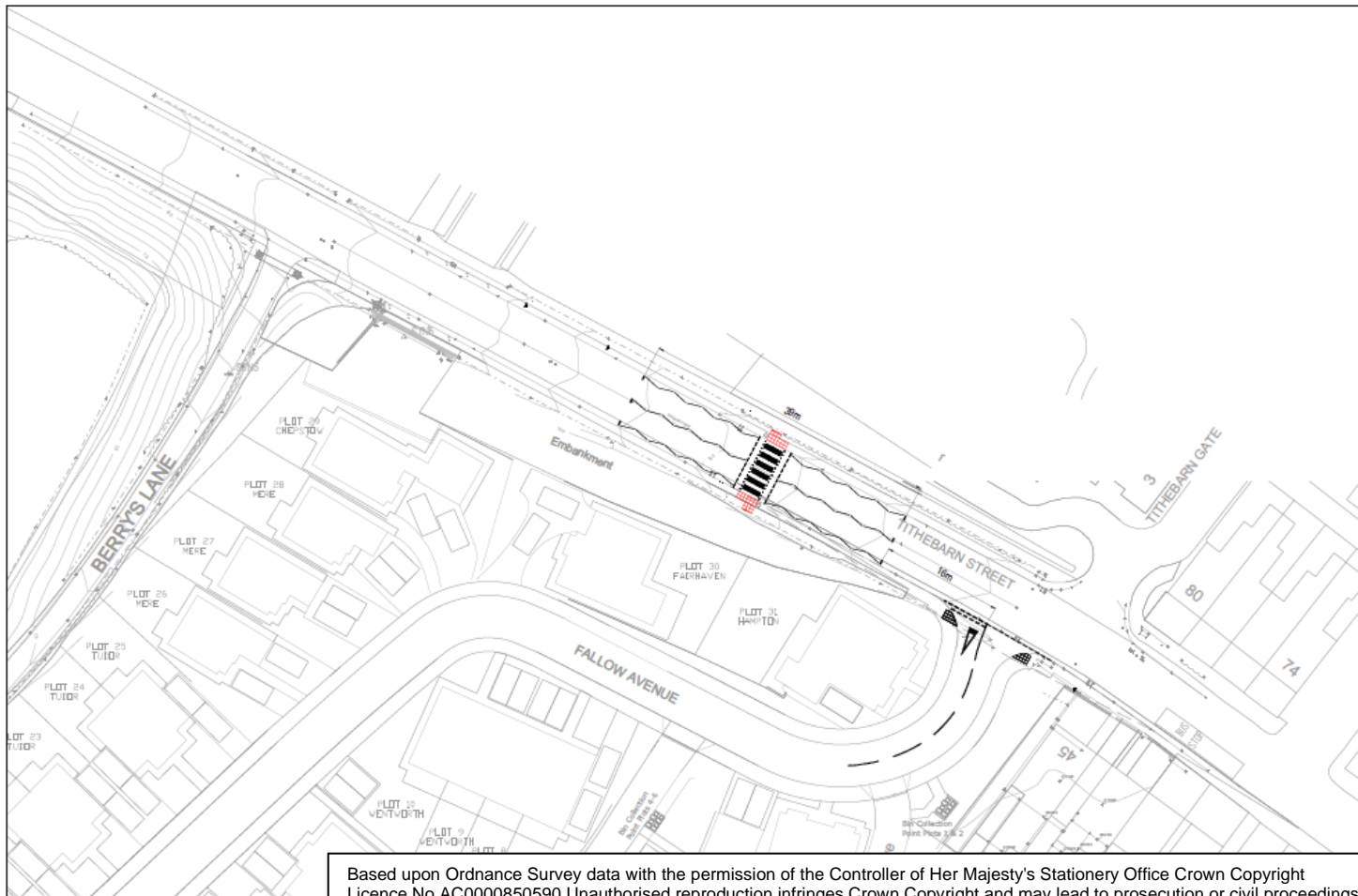


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(TITHEBARN STREET, POULTON-LE-FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH)**  
**(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Tithebarn Street, from a point 16 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Fallow Avenue for a distance of 39 metres in a north westerly direction.



**Statement of Reasons**

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development which will introduce further traffic movements around Tithebarn Street. The purpose of the proposed Zebra crossing is to provide a safe crossing point for pedestrians in order to promote sustainable travel and promote social inclusion.
