- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0935 hours on Thursday 4th July 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 17th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works to make safe a dangerous void in the carriageway due to a defective sewer to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
