**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Hill House Lane, Brindle from its junction with Sandy Lane for approximately 20 metres in a north westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent repair to leaking main in the carriageway to be carried out.
