(SANDYGATE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sandygate, Burnley, from its junction with Neptune Street to its junction with Queens Lancashire Way.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on 29th July 2024 until 2359 hours on 20th September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access to the Maltings Mill (Little Lancashire Village Nursery) carpark will be maintained at all times.
 Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Neptune Street – Wiseman Street – Westgate – Queens Lancashire Way and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow footway and carriageway upgrade works to be carried out by Barnfield Construction.
