NEW TOWNS

The Central Lancashire New Towns (Designation) Order 1970

Made	26th March 1970
Laid before Parliament	13th April 1970
Coming into Operation	14th April 1970

Whereas the Minister of Housing and Local Government (hereinafter called "The Minister") is satisfied, after consultation with all local authorities who appear to him to be concerned, that it is expedient in the national interest that an area of land of approximately 35,225 acres comprising the whole area of the county borough of Preston and parts of the borough of Chorley, parts of the urban districts of Fulwood, Leyland and Walton-le-Dale, and parts of the rural district of Chorley and Preston in the administrative county of Lancashire should be developed as a new town:

Now therefore the Minister, in exercise of his powers under section 1(1) of the New Towns Act 1965 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

1. In this order "the map" means the map prepared in duplicate, sealed with the official seal of the Minister and marked "Map referred to in the Central Lancashire New Town (Designation) Order 1970", of which one duplicate has been deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Lancashire County Council and the other at the offices of the Minister.
2. The land shown enclosed by a black line edged externally by a broad blue line on the map is hereby designated as the site of a new town.
3. This order may be cited as the Central Lancashire New Town (Designation) Order 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates an area of about 35,225 acres comprising the county borough of Preston and parts of the administrative county of Lancashire as the site of a new town to be developed under the New Towns Act 1965 by a development corporation established under that Act. The area is shown on the map forming part of this Note. The coming into operation date of the Order is that of the first publication in the London Gazette of notice of its making (see paragraph 7 of Schedule 1 to the Act).
