(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Eshton Terrace, Clitheroe, from 20 metres west of the level crossing to 20 metres east of the level crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0035 hours on Sunday the 1st of September 2024 until 0730 hours on Sunday the 22nd of September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The overnight prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Thorn Street – Bawdlands (B6243) – Castle Gate – Moor Lane (B6478) – Woone Lane – Eshton Terrace

6. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure is via:-

Henthorn Road - Dean Meadow - Henthorn Park - Victoria Street - West View

6. Emergency access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing barrier and pedestal renewal works to be carried out.
