(REAR 1-21 DEEPDALE ROAD, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 1-21 Deepdale Road, Fleetwood at the rear of house number 48 Addison Road for approximately 10 metres in both a north-easterly and south-westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Wednesday 24th July 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 26th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of immediate works to make safe a dangerous void in the carriageway due to a defective sewer to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
