(REAR 2-50 POULTON ROAD, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 2-50 Poulton Road, Fleetwood, at the rear of house number 18 Poulton Road for approximately 5 metres in both an easterly and westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Tuesday 23rd July 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 26th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of immediate sewer repair works and make safe a dangerous void in the carriageway to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
