(REAR 2-50 POULTON ROAD, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 2-50 Poulton Road, Fleetwood, at the rear of house number 18 Poulton Road for approximately 5 metres in both an easterly and westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Tuesday 23rd July 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 26th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of immediate sewer repair works and make safe a dangerous void in the carriageway to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
