## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(SKITHAM LANE, PILLING, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Skitham Lane, Pilling from its junction with Longmoor Lane for approximately 300 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Skitham Lane – Lancaster Road – Bradshaw Lane – Garstang Road – Black Lane – Cartmell Lane – Longmoor Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
