Members of Wiswell Parish Council have asked me to forward the following additional comments relating to the above:

Concerning the existing Footpath 9 reached from the top of Moor Lane, access is only available by climbing over a tied gate and there is no signage. The footpath is visible when coming down the moor to the closed gate although there is a shortage of way markers on the top of Wiswell Moor.

The existing Path 9 is a much better path than the proposed diversion along the old track which is already in use as an informal path. The old track is very wet indeed and some drainage and surface works could be required in order to make this a reasonable route for a formal footpath or bridleway.

Firstly, I can confirm that we (myself and my wife) own the land outlined in the letter you sent. That is, the land over which proposed route from A-F runs.

I have some comments about the application:

- Some people have described the wooden gate at point A as a bridleway gate. This is not correct, it's a gate designed for pedestrian access (to FP 23) and for vehicular access for my own and the neighbouring farmer's vehicles (in particular a quad bike and tractor).
- I very rarely see horses on the route (I can recall seeing riders once in the last 2 years). I was in the house at that time so it wasn't convenient to speak to them.
- In my opinion, the route isn't considered to be a bridleway by the general public. In fact, in a previous claim to upgrade the route (number 804/124/3/47/1), which was not accepted, the Clerk to the Parish Council commented "for quite a long period in the past the then farmer maintained stiles alongside these gates and kept the gates themselves locked to deter horse riding".
- The route isn't currently considered a bridleway because it's not suitable. As stated in
