On 14 December, 2000 Ribble Valley Borough Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will be to divert the public footpath running from A-B to C-D on the order map.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen, free of charge, at Level C of the Ribble Valley Borough Council, Council Offices, Church Walk, Clitheroe between 8.45am and 5.00pm on weekdays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.40.

This Order comes into force on 12 January 2001, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice and make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by Ribble Valley Borough Council under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Authority in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Lancashire County Council and relevant consultees have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Manor House Farm, Moor Lane, Wiswell in the borough of Ribble Valley shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped-up after 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall be at the end of the 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Manor House Farm, Moor Lane, Wiswell in the borough of Ribble Valley described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
