

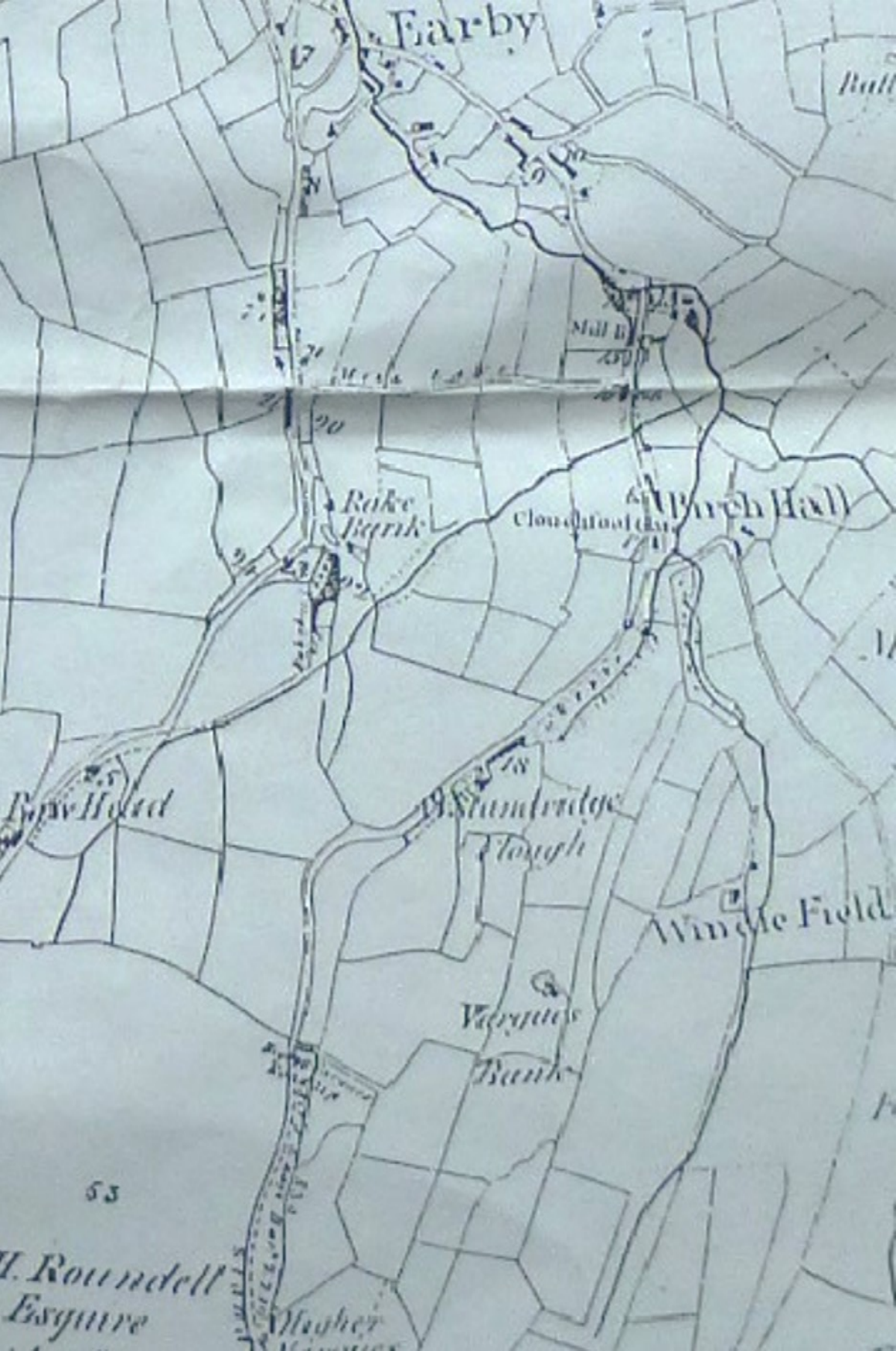

 appointed by the said first mentioned Act and a true survey admeasurement and Value
 and Valuation upon the estate of the said Henry Seal were before me in pursuance
 of the directions of the said Shro. a Copy of certain Value is returned annexed. Item
whereof that of the said William Pilkington in pursuance of the Writ
sent in me by the said Shro. of Warrington to make this my award in
writing in manner following that is to say It is in the first place to be
award that the whole of the said Common Moor and Waste Lands do contain
in whole measure according to the said Survey nine hundred and sixty nine acres
one rood and seven courses. And of the said Common Moor before as proceeded
before the said Shro. directed to be made by virtue of the said first mentioned
Act did set out and appoint the following Vicarage Moor Waste Moor
and Foot Ways in or over and upon the said Common Moor and Waste Lands by the
said first mentioned Act directed to be directed and intoned and where the said Moor
is delineated in the said Warrant is to say One Public Carriage Road Public
Highway of the width of thirty feet as and where the same is set out
commencing at the Colne and Shipton Turnpike Road on Thornton Moor near
Woolthorpe and leading in a North Westerly direction across the same Moor
the Township of Easingwold Road & did distinguish by the name of the
Woolthorpe Road one other Public Carriage Road and
Highway - the width of thirty feet commencing at Moor Gate and leading
in a southerly direction over the Moor to the North End of God Lane which
is distinguished by the name of Moor Gate Road another Public Public
Road and Private Carriage Road and Highway of the width and
of thirty feet commencing at an ancient gate in the Moor side belonging to Henry Private
Alcock Esquire near Dodgson House and leading in a South Easterly direction across Road
Thornton Moor to the Colne and Shipton Turnpike Road in the Township of Private
Easingwold and which Road I have distinguished by the name of Dodgson Private
House Road one other Private Carriage and Occupation Road Private
of the width of thirty feet commencing at Dodgson House Moor on Henry Moor
and leading in a North Westerly direction across allotments sold to John Sanderson
Jonathan Gray and Sir John Potes Esqrs & thence to an ancient lane leading
westward to Slough which Road I distinguished by the name of Standridge
Slough Road one other Private Carriage and Occupation
Road of the width of thirty feet commencing at the Colne and Shipton Turnpike
Road on Henry Moor near Henry Side and leading in a North Westerly and
Westerly direction across allotments sold to Sir John Potes Esqrs & thence to John
Smith and Richard Worsley Esquires copartners to an ancient lane near a place Public
named East Barn Road and which Road I distinguished by the name of Public
East Barn Road one other Private Carriage and Occupation Road of
the width of thirty four feet commencing at the East End of Hamer Lane and
leading in a South Easterly and Easterly direction to the South West corner of an
allotment set out to the Vicar of Thornton for George Hamer in an Easterly direction
across the same allotment and another allotment also set out to the said Vicar for
George Hamer to the North East corner of an allotment sold to Sir John Potes Esqrs and
thence in a South Easterly direction to the North End of the Woolthorpe Road and

 Road is distinguished by the name of Wainman's Field Road one other private

 in a Westerly direction are an inclosure set out upon the West side of the said
 Wainman which Road is distinguished by the name of Kitchen Road one
 other private carriage and occupation Road of the width of twenty
 one foot branching out of the said and Sir John Wainman Moor and leading
 in a Westerly direction are the said inclosure set out to certain Francis and James
 Wainman which Road is distinguished by the name of Burnt Hill
Wainman Road one other private carriage and occupation Road of the width of
 twenty one foot running at an ancient inclosure sold to the said Sir John Viotre
 alias to an ancient inclosure belonging to the said Sir John Viotre alias
 which Road is distinguished by the name of Wainman's Bank
 Road. And I do order direct and award that that the several
 private carriage and occupation Roads shall at all times hereafter be
 supported and kept in repair by such persons and in such manner as other
 private carriage and occupation Roads are by law supported and kept in repair.
 And I do order direct and award that proper and convenient
 signs or sufficient dimensions shall be made in and across all and every the private
 carriage and occupation Roads in all places where it is or shall or may hereafter be found
 necessary that neither man nor beast may pass across the same Roads. And that all
