The said lands tenements and hereditaments so purchased by  
 the said William Wilkinton have in further pursuance of the directions of the  
 said Acts passed a true and perfect survey advertisement value and valuation of  
 all the said Common Moor and Waste Lands and also of all the Vicarage  
 tithes the said Vicarage and Parsonage of Thornton to be made and reduced into writing  
 by Henry Seal of Leeds in the said County and in respect being the receiver  
 appointed by the said first mentioned Act and a true survey advertisement and value  
 and valuation upon the estate of the said Henry Seal were before me in pursuance  
 of the directions of the said Acts a copy of which value is hereto annexed. Item  
whereas that of the said William Pilkington in pursuance of the Statute  
 made in that behalf by the said Acts of Parliament to make this my award in  
writing in manner following that is to say it is in the first place to declare and  
award that the whole of the said Common Moor and Waste Lands do contain  
 in whole measure according to the said survey nine hundred and sixty nine acres  
 one rood and seven courses. And of the said Common Moor before expressed  
 be set out the allotments directed to be made by virtue of the said first mentioned  
 Act did set out and appoint the following Vicarage tithes Vicarage tithes  
 and foot ways in over and upon the said Common Moor and Waste Lands by the  
 said first mentioned Act directed to be directed and intended and where the said tithes  
 are delineated in the said value that is to say One Public Carriage Road  
Highway of the width of thirty feet as and where the same is set out  
 commencing at the Colne and Skipton Turnpike Road on Thornton Moor near  
 Wuthliffe Road and leading in a North westerly direction across the same Moor  
 the Township of Ewbank which Road I did distinguish by the name of the  
Wuthliffe Road one other Public Carriage Road and  
Highway - the width of thirty feet commencing at Moor Gate and leading

Slough Road one other Private Carriage and Occupation
