Tyres: the 'fatal fifth'

However, there exists a silent yet equally significant threat on our roads – the 'fatal fifth': **TYRES**.

Tyres are the only point of contact between a vehicle and the road, making their condition and maintenance paramount to road safety. Despite their critical role, tyres often take a backseat in discussions about road safety. This oversight is a stark contrast to their importance, as highlighted by alarming statistics and real-world consequences.



over 6 million tyres in the UK
have illegal tread each year,
posing a significant risk to road
users. Not only does this endanger
lives, but it also carries hefty
penalties of up to £2,500 per tyre
and three penalty points.

Furthermore, underinflated tyres contribute to **over £1 billion worth of wasted fuel annually in the UK**, accounting for more than 50% of tyres on the road.





The impact of tyre neglect extends beyond financial losses. Over 2 million MOT failures occur each year due to tyre defects, with one

million classified as dangerous. Shockingly, tyres are the primary cause of MOT failures in the first seven years of a vehicle's life. Moreover, incidents related to defective tyres claim the lives of 152 people and cause serious injuries annually — a figure on par with mobile phone-related incidents.



In addition to the human toll, tyre defects also lead to significant inconveniences. One in five vehicle breakdowns on motorways and A roads result from tyre defects, amounting to roughly 50,000 breakdowns each year on the motorway network alone. These

network alone. These are not just statistics; they represent lives lost, financial burdens, and unnecessary inconveniences.

It is against this backdrop that TyreSafe issues a compelling call to action, urging all drivers to A.C.T. on tyre safety. The time to prioritise tyre maintenance and awareness is now, as we collectively strive to mitigate the risks associated with the 'fatal fifth' and ensure safer journeys for all road users.

Tread


and measure the tread depth to ensure it meets legal requirements.


