(U311 NEW LANE, CROSSENS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U311 New Lane, Crossens from the boundary between Sefton Council and Lancashire County Council to the western boundary of property number 44.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0930 hours and 1500 hours from Monday 12th August 2024 until Tuesday 13th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will not be provided owing to the fact there is no suitable diversion available for this closure.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management in conjunction with BT.
