(U301 CRABTREE LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of U301 Crabtree Lane, Burscough for a distance of 20m either side of Crabtree Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 17th August 2024 until 0815 hours on Sunday 18th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for cyclists will be maintained on foot by dismounting.**
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular and cycle traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U301 Crabtree Lane, Burscough – C137 Red Cat Lane, South of Crabtree Lane (Burscough) – A59 Liverpool Road North, Burscough – U396 Orrell Lane, Burscough – U301 Crabtree Lane, Burscough and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow track inspection works at the level crossing to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
