(U294 MARTIN LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U294 Martin Lane, Burscough from its junction with U296 Gorst Lane, Burscough to southern boundary of property number 20.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0930 hours and 1500 hours from Wednesday 21st August 2024 until Thursday 22nd August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that the affected section of U294 Martin Lane, Burscough is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management on behalf of BT.
