(BACK LANE, MAWDESLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Mawdesley from its junction with Gorsey Lane, Mawdesley to the eastern boundary of the property named South View.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 21st August 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 23rd August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Gorsey Lane, Mawdesley – New Street, Mawdesley – Hall Lane, Mawdesley – Dark Lane, Mawdesley – Bradshaw Lane, Mawdesley and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities
