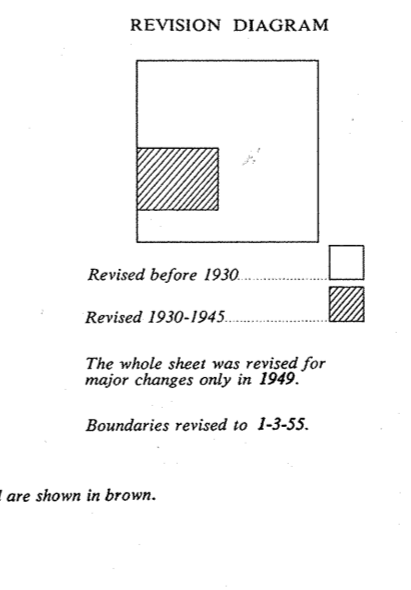

If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference 842159 recurs at intervals of 100 Kilometres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case with maps on scales of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.

At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 0° 11' East of Grid North and at the Western edge 0° 15' East of Grid North.

Magnetic North was about 10° West of Grid North in 1555 decreasing by about 1° in four years.

Heights are in feet above Mean Sea Level at Newlyn.

If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference 830119 recurs at intervals of 100 Kilometres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case with maps on scales of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.

At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 0° 11' East of Grid North and at the Western edge 0° 15' East of Grid North.

Magnetic North was about 10° West of Grid North in 1955 decreasing by about 1" in four years. Heights are in feet above Mean Sea Level at Newlyn.
