**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Moss Hall Road, Accrington from Moss Hall Road, from its junction with Whalley Road to outside 2A Moss Hall Road
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 2. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order
- 5 An alternative route for vehicular traffic (except HGVs) affected by the closure is via:- A680 Whalley Road Queensborough Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow chamber frame and cover works to be carried out on behalf of Network Plus
