(PRINCESS WAY, EUXTON, CHORLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Princess Way, Euxton, from its junction with Countess Way, for a distance of 34 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Thursday 26th September or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Countess Way – Barons Way – Regents Way and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer maintenance works to be carried out.
