LARCH STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Larch Street, Nelson from outside number 96 Larch Street to approximately 30 metres in a south westerly direction outside entrance to Farmhouse Biscuits.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2024 until 1800 hours on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Bracewell Street – Netherfield Road – Brook Street – Chapel House Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out.
