(MARSH LANE, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to wait at any time on that length of Marsh Lane, Longton from a point 70 metres east of its junction with The Maltings to its junction with River View Court.
- 2. To temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle from loading and unloading on that length of Marsh Lane, Longton from a point 70 metres east of its junction with The Maltings to its junction with River View Court.
- 3. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 4. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 24th October 2024 until 1800 hours on Wednesday 29th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 6. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not available.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow highway improvement works to be carried out.
